Unit III: Lesson 1 Wind Streamers: Holidays Blow In

Talk to your teacher about all the different holidays you can think of. Decide on one for which you can make a wind streamer.

Example for a 4th of July streamer:

Have a grown up cut a piece of 4" x 24" blue poster board. Draw 5 or 6 stars on white paper, cut them out, and glue them on the blue poster board. Use red and white crepe paper to make 8 streamers 30" long. Glue them to the blue poster board on the inside. Bring the two ends of the poster board together to make a ring. Tape or staple the ends together. Punch two holes near the top. Thread ribbon or string through the holes. Hang the streamers outdoors if possible.

Use different colors and shapes for different holidays. Hang your streamers outside your classroom.

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
