Unit III: Lesson 3 Identification: Picture Frame

Find out these important pieces of information about yourself: name, address, phone number, birth date. Neatly print the information on a 3" x 5" card. Get a 2" x 3" picture of yourself and glue it on the card.

Make a picture frame in which you can display this important information about yourself. Have a grown-up cut two 6" x 8" pieces of mat board for you. Have the adult cut a 3" x 5" opening in one piece through which your picture and information will show. Glue the two sides together at the bottom. Leave the top open. Decorate the boarders with glitter or pretty stones, shells, pictures, or whatever else you would like. When the frame dries, insert the picture card.

After showing your picture to your teacher, hang your identification picture frame in your room.
