Map: Different Land Different Jobs

Choose two countries in different parts of the world that have very different natural resources. List the natural resources that are different. Read about the countries to find out what jobs the people in each of the two countries have. Make lists of those jobs.

Study your lists of jobs. Find the jobs that only exist in one of the countries and not in the other country. Think about the natural resources that are in one country that are not in the other. Decide how much the jobs that are different depend on the natural resources of each country.

Draw a map of each country. Show the natural resources in each country that are different. Make a key for each map. Write the names of the jobs that depend on the natural resources of each country. If possible, draw pictures of the workers in those jobs. Arrange the map and the information in a display. Make it clear to others what you have learned about how the jobs in a country depend on the natural resources in that country.

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
