Letter: Bible Study Invitation

With help from your local conference office, research what cities or towns near your community have no nearby Seventh-day Adventist church or other institution.

Select one city or town for this project. Compose a letter in which you invite the recipient to enroll in a Bible correspondence course. Enclose an enrollment card, which you may obtain from the Voice of Prophecy or It Is Written. Have your teacher approve the letter before you send it. Determine the number of letters you will send. Obtain a telephone directory from the city or town and choose names and addresses, selecting every tenth name for variety. Decide how the postage and stationery will be funded. Make copies of your approved letter and invite students in your classroom to help with this project. Place a special mark on the cards, so you will be able to determine the percentage of cards returned.

Once your project is organized, prepare the letters for mailing and mail them. Contact the Voice of Prophecy or It Is Written to find out how many enrollment cards come back to them.

Consider what you may do as a follow-up or future project.

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
