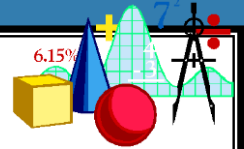

Art: **Warped Art**



A process called anamorphosis was popular from about 1550 to 1850. It involved painting a distorted picture which could only be viewed correctly by means of a cone or cylindrical shaped mirror. Look for examples of these paintings on the Internet.

After studying some examples, draw, using a cylindrical mirror, a design including your name. A mirror can be made out of chrome tubing or silver Mylar wrapping paper.

Arrange to display your work. Attach a brief explanation of this type of art, including how this technique could be used in some practical way, perhaps photographically.
