Contributing: **Milk Carton Bank**



Think about and discuss the ways that your church needs you. Some examples are your presence, helpfulness, encouragement, and giving.

Decide on a project at your church to which you would like to make a contribution. Make a bank in which to save money for the project. Obtain a small 8 oz. milk carton and some sand. Fill a paper cup one half full of sand. Fill it with water and a few drops of your favorite food coloring. Stir well and let the sand soak for several hours. Lay the sand out on waxed paper to dry for at least 12 hours. Tape the milk carton closed. Ask an adult cut a slit in the top for coins and bills to slip through. Paint a coat of white glue all over the milk carton and roll it in the colored sand.
